How Assistive Listening Devices Can Enhance Your Hearing Aids

There are many Assistive Listening Devices (ALDs) that can enhance and improve your performance when using a hearing instrument. Here are just a few examples of what's available to you:

• STREAMERS

A streamer is a device that can be worn around the neck or kept in your pocket that allow you to wirelessly connect to your cell phone or listen to music from an audio source with Bluetooth capability.

MEDIA DEVICES

A media device can be wired to your TV, stereo, or any sound source. The sound travels from the device to your hearing aids wirelessly, providing natural, clear sound without ambient noise interference.

REMOTE MICROPHONES

In particularly loud listening environments, hearing aids alone may not always be enough. Having a companion or loved one wear a microphone (on their lapel or shirt collar) will allow their voice to be streamed directly into your hearing aids, ensuring you hear them over the surrounding noise.
